Submission deadline for Abstracts

If you would like to submit an abstract, please complete the Abstract submission form before **December 15, 2025** in order for your submission to be considered. All submissions will be forwarded to the program committee for review.

Preparing your Abstract

Please review the submission guidelines, criteria, terms and conditions.

All submissions should contain:

- Name, e-mail address, professional affiliation, and telephone number of the presenting author
- A title describing the content of the work
- The names of all the authors included in the work
- A structured abstract of no more than 300 words, (not including authors and affiliations, keywords, and category heading) is required
- 4 keywords
- Preferred type of presentation: Poster presentation, consideration for oral presentation (with slides)

Abstract submission instruction

Criteria

Abstracts will be judged on:

- 1) relevance to the field of exercise oncology
- 2) potential impact
- 3) scientific rigor (if applicable); and
- 4) writing style.

Conditions for presentations

- At least one of the authors should register for the conference.
- A maximum of 1 abstract per first author may be submitted.
- All presenters must complete a conflict of interest statement disclosing any commercial or other involvements that pertain to the content of their presentation.
- All education provided will be free of commercial bias, attempts to sell equipment or advocate software or equipment. The only exception to this will be educational presentations that are specifically geared towards a particular treatment approach.
- Presenters may provide basic contact information, a description of relevant services they
 offer and how they might be contacted. Otherwise, solicitation or sales during an educational
 presentation are not allowed.
- The abstracts of accepted posters will be published in *Translational Journal of the American College of Sports Medicine (TJACSM)* and on the website to which only the conference participants have access.

Authors of accepted abstracts who cancel their presentation after April 1, 2026 will not be permitted to submit for the next conference.
